Quick Grants

The Shire's quick grants programs provide financial and in-kind support to local organisations and for initiatives which benefit the local community. This program provides up to \$500 per organisation per financial year.

Annual Grants - \$1,000 +

The purpose of an annual grant is to effectively and consistently deal with a variety of large requests for funding that Council receives. This

grant occurs bi-annually each year. Closing dates are typically the end of May (Round 1) and the end of September (Round 2).
