## QUICK GRANT

Up to \$500, these primarily cater for small projects and initiatives that are unlikely to be planned many months in advance

Any organisation or group can apply, just fill in the "Quick Grant Application" and email it to [events@swek.wa.gov.au](mailto:events@swek.wa.gov.au)



## FACILITIES

To assist groups within the Shire to upgrade, extend or build new facilities that will benefit the community.

To apply, you must first discuss your project with the Community Grant & Events Officer. Send in a project outline to [events@swek.wa.gov.au](mailto:events@swek.wa.gov.au)



## EVENTS

Supports organisations to develop and conduct sustainable local and regional community events that celebrate diversity, creativity, inclusion and a vibrant community.

If you have a community based event, please fill in an "Events Grant Application" form and return to the Shire. These approvals can take up to 2-3 months.



## RATES

To support not for profit community groups and associations occupying rateable land.

Apply with "Rate Assistance Application" form. If approved, you will be required to pay your rates in full and then invoice the Shire the amount of the rates.



## COMMUNITY SUPPORT

In response to the state of emergencies and times of crisis, the Shire will offer one-off grants designed to support not-for-profit organisations and community groups to continue to maintain community services.

COVID-19 has had a huge effect on some community groups. If you experiencing financial hardship as a result, you can apply for the "Community Support Grant Application".



## COMMUNITY PROGRAM

One off grants and three-year service agreements for not for profit community groups with a focus on community development programs and services that align with the Shire's Strategic Community Plan.

Apply via the "Community Programs Grant" form. Please ensure you include as much information on the application as possible.



## FUTURE LEADERS AWARD
