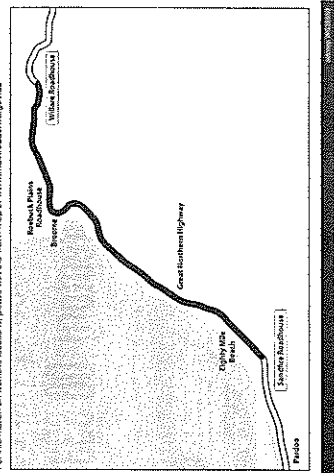
Morning School Zone Speed Time Change
