DECOMMISSIONING SEPTIC SYSTEMS

The Shire of Wyndham East Kimberley recommends that once connection to sewer has been made, any septic system be decommissioned as soon as possible, as septic systems can collapse without warning. However, you are legally obligated to decommission the apparatus within 60 days of a change of use i.e. subdivision, or ownership of the premises, or before building work commences where foundations for a building are to be built closer than 1.2m to a septic tank, 1.8m from a leach drain or where a building is proposed above an apparatus.

STEPS INVOLVED

When decommissioning, only a licensed Liquid Waste Contractor is to be used.

- 1. Empty all septic tanks, soak wells, leach drains or other on-site disposal systems.
- 2. Remove the leach drains, soak wells and tanks (or if impractical remove the lids and break the base of the tanks)
- 3. Backfilling the excavation, tanks, soak wells and leach drains with clean fill (e.g. yellow sand and then thoroughly compacted).
- 4. Submit the completed form including photographs to provide evidence that the septic systems have been suitably decommissioned.
