

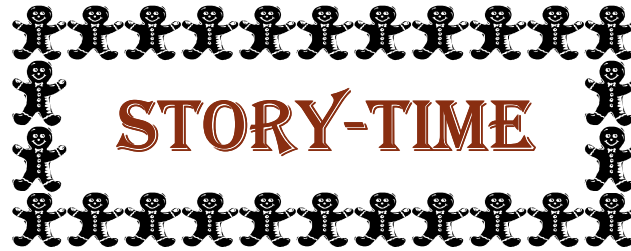
How to become a member

You need a valid Western Australian driver's license, or approved document that shows your current Kununurra postal address.

The alternative is to become a temporary borrower by paying a \$20 (2 items) or \$50 (5 items) refundable deposit.

Visitors who are members of another WA public library may present their current library card (and ID) in exchange for a Kununurra Community Library card.

Caravan Park residents and those residents without a Kununurra Post Office Box number will be required to join as a temporary member.



The library hosts a storytime for children, each Thursday morning at 8.30am.

There is a rhyme-time with fun action songs, then a simple story is read to children, followed by a craft activity. Parents and children are encouraged to get involved with enjoying books together.

Tea and coffee is served after the session. All are welcome.

- Costs for lost or damaged items must be paid before borrowing can resume.
