WHEN TO NOMINATE

Nominations open on 3 March 2010 and close at 4.00pm sharp on 10 March 2010.

WHERE TO NOMINATE

At the Shire of Wyndham East Kimberley offices, Coolibah Drive Kununurra and/or Koolama Street Wyndham.

Nominations must be on a prescribed form that is available from the Council office at either Wyndham or Kununurra. An \$80 nomination deposit is required together with your profile consisting of no more than 150 words on an A4 sheet. You can include a recent passport-sized photo with your nomination if you wish. If unable to personally attend to nominate, an authorised agent can do this on your behalf.
