



On ANZAC Day in 1923, the first Commemorative Dawn Service was held in Albany, Western Australia. This location was the last sight of land ANZAC troops saw after leaving Australian shores and some of them never returned.

As the sun was rising, a man in a small dinghy cast a wreath into King George Sound while a band of about 20 men gathered on the summit of nearby Mount Clarence, silently watching the wreath float out to sea.

Reverend White, a padre and one of the earliest ANZACs then quietly recited the words: *'As the sun rises and goeth down, we will remember them'*.

We hold a service at the first light of dawn each ANZAC Day to commemorate our fallen soldiers.

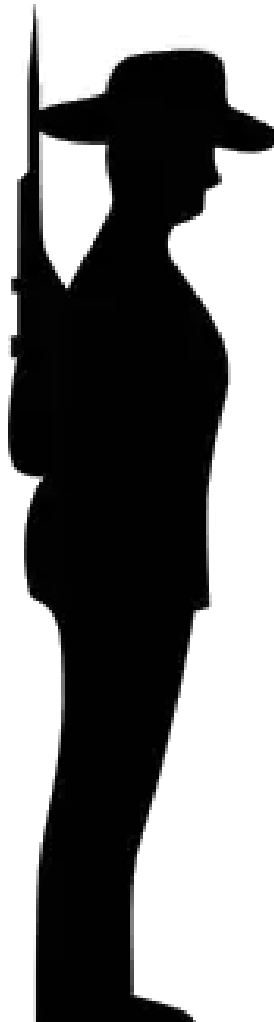
AUSTRALIAN NATIONAL ANTHEM
