NOTICE OF INTENTION TO LEVY DIFFERENTIAL RATES FOR THE YEAR ENDING 30 JUNE 2017

In accordance with Section 6.36 of the Local Government Act 1995, notice is hereby given of the intention of the City of Belmont to adopt the following rates in the dollar for Gross Rental Value and Minimum Payments for each differential rating category in the 2016-2017 financial year.

Rate Category	Rate in the Dollar (Cents)	Minimum Payments
Residential	4.6289	\$800
Commercial	5.3695	\$945
Industrial	5.3927	\$965

This represents a 1.47% increase in the rate yield (1.50% increase in the Rate in the Dollar) from Residential, Commercial, Industrial properties. Residential minimum payments have increased 1.3%, Commercial minimum payments have increased 1.6%, Industrial minimum payments have increased 1.6%.

It is also intended to levy a separate rubbish charge of \$293.30 per 240 litre cart that is removed weekly. There is no increase to 2016-17 charges. In addition, to a standard weekly service the following charges (GST exempt) apply: \$205.31 for an additional rubbish service; \$102.66 for an additional recycling service; \$395.96 per annum for non-rateable properties for one 240 litre cart removed weekly (\$293.30 for additional services); \$102.66 for exempted commercial and industrial properties; \$205.31 per unit for R80 and above coded multi-residential properties (excludes flexible coded).

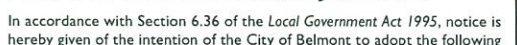

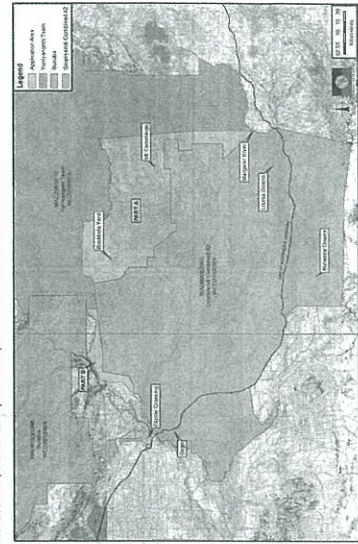

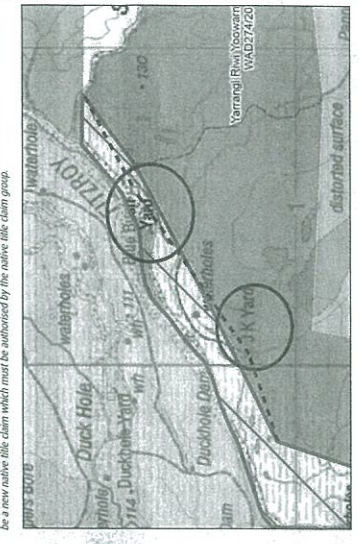
