

Request for Voluntary Self-Exclusion from TAMS

The Kununurra Wyndham Liquor Accord has received requests from individuals wishing to voluntarily exclude themselves from being able to purchase takeaway alcohol through the TAMS. To enable the system to identify those that wish to self exclude themselves from purchasing takeaway alcohol, please complete the below.

Q. What is Voluntary Self-Exclusion?

A. Voluntary Self-Exclusion allows a person to nominate themselves to be excluded from being able to purchase alcohol from a liquor outlet that uses the Takeaway Alcohol Management System (TAMS). Once registered the person will no longer be able to purchase any takeaway alcohol within the Shire.

Q. Why has this option become available?

A. The Kununurra Wyndham Alcohol Accord have received feedback from community members that this process should be an option. There is concern that some people will be humbugged into purchasing alcohol for others, and others believe it will assist to reduce their own personal consumption of alcohol.

Q. How does the system work?

A. Once the person has registered for Voluntary Self-Exclusion and this application has been processed, the TAMS service provider will add the information into the system. When the person tries to purchase alcohol the TAMS will decline the purchase but will not disclose the reason for the refusal.



Q. How do I voluntary exclude myself?

A. If you want to voluntarily exclude yourself from being able to purchase takeaway alcohol within the Shire of Wyndham East Kimberley, simply complete and submit the "Request for voluntary Self - Exclusion from TAMS" form, found at the back of this brochure. The form must then be submitted in person to either Kununurra or Wyndham Police Station. Please ensure you take your valid photo identification with you as this will be required with the submission.

Q. What happens once I submit the form?

A. Once the form has been submitted to your local Police Station this will be forwarded onto the Officer in Charge at Kununurra Police who will submit the information to Scantek, the TAMS service provider.

Please allow 7 working days for the change to take place.

Q. What if I would like to opt back into using the system?

A. If you have voluntarily self-excluded yourself from the Takeaway Alcohol Management System but then decide you would like to again be able to purchase takeaway alcohol, you must complete the required form at your local Police Station. Once the form has been completed and you have presented your valid photo identification, your form will be forwarded onto the Officer in Charge at Kununurra Police who will submit the information to Scantek, the TAMS service provider.

Please allow 7 working days for the change to take place.
