

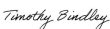

Staff housing aims to attract new workers

Aged care provider Juniper has celebrated the opening of 11 permanent staff homes in Fitzroy Crossing.

The accommodation, located next to the Guwardi Ngadu residential aged care home, is aimed at addressing acute housing shortages and strengthening aged care services in the West Kimberley by providing secure housing for staff.

Juniper chief executive Russell Bricknell said the project was a significant investment and a major win for culturally appropriate aged care in the region.

"We are delighted to celebrate the opening of accommodation to support and sustain our staff," Mr Bricknell said.

"Permanent, quality staff accommodation is vital in remote areas to help us attract and retain highly skilled aged care workers."

"Over the years we've had the support of Marra Worra Worra Aboriginal Corporation's Fitzroy workers camp for our staff which continues to play a critical role in providing safe and affordable accommodation for Fitzroy Crossing workers."

The opening comes as the State Government continues to focus on the housing crisis in the Kimberley in the latest Budget announcement on May 7.
