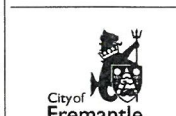

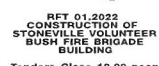

WHAT IS THE AUTHORISATION MEETING FOR?

The Wanggil native title claim was made when the State Government gave notice of a decision to compulsorily acquire and extinguish native title rights and interests in an area of Land (Lot 625 on Deposited Plan 409302) shown in pink on the map. The purpose of the authorisation meeting is for the Wanggil native title claim group to receive legal advice about, and then decide whether to authorise and instruct the Applicant to enter into, an ILUA that means native title will not be extinguished and withdraw the Wanggil native title claim.
