SOCEROOS SET TO POP

GEORGE CLARKE

Tony Popovic reckons he wouldn't have been ready to take the Socceroos job five years ago.

But after being unveiled as Graham Arnold's replacement on Monday, the 51-year-old is set for a rapid baptism as he attempts to turn around Australia's World Cup qualification campaign.

This time last week Popovic, right, was relaxing with his family in Croatia after leaving Melbourne Victory without a job earlier this year. In three weeks, he will be attempting to down China in Adelaide before heading to face unbeaten Japan five days later.

Three points across those two games will be a mini-

mum expectation if the Socceroos want to qualify automatically after a winless start to round three with a loss to Bahrain and a draw away to Indonesia.

"I watched the games over the weekend, I didn't get a chance to see them live from Croatia (and) the team maybe looked a little bit flat," Popovic said.

"That can happen in games ... but there are obviously some areas there that I believe we can improve.

"Maybe we can be a little bit more dynamic, we can move the ball quicker, we can get more players in the box, but these are things that they were doing which brought a lot of success.

"The last two games, there wasn't a lot of evidence of that, and I'm sure we can get that back and do it even better moving forward."

Notice of Authorisation Meeting for Karajari Native Title Holders Gingerah Energy Hub Project - Indigenous Land Use Agreement

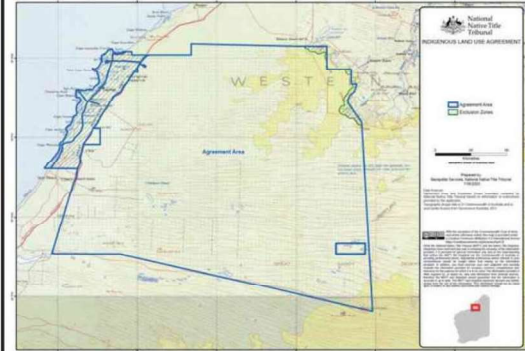
Who: Karajari native title holders who are the persons identified as native title holders in the Karajari native title determinations ("Karajari People"), who:
a) are of Karajari descent;
b) identify as Karajari and are accepted as such by the Karajari;
c) adhere to Karajari customs and traditions; and
d) are by Karajari laws and customs entitled to the use or occupation of the Karajari lands irrespective of whether or not the traditional entitlement is qualified as to place, time, circumstance, purpose or permission and includes those persons having native title thereto under common law.

Background: The Karajari Traditional Lands Association (Aboriginal Corporation) RNTBC ("KTALA") has been negotiating a Joint Venture Deed with Longreach Capital and Fugro Australia in relation to the development of the Gingerah Energy Hub Project on Karajari country with each party to hold a 33.3% share of the Gingerah Energy Joint Venture.

To support the development of the project, the KTALA have also been negotiating an ILUA ("Gingerah Project ILUA") with the soon to be established Gingerah Energy Joint Venture (which the KTALA will be a 33.3% shareholder of) which would provide the necessary native title consents and approvals for feasibility studies to be progressed and, if those feasibility studies are successful, to develop a large scale renewable energy project which could comprise a mix of solar, wind and geothermal energy.

Purpose: At the authorisation meeting, the Karajari People will be asked to decide whether to consent to the native title decision for the KTALA to enter into the Gingerah Energy Project ILUA.

The ILUA will contain native title consents and cultural heritage and environmental approvals processes for:
• Further feasibility studies including site investigation works on Karajari country for a large scale renewable energy project; and
• If those feasibility studies are successful, the future grant of renewable energy tenure within the Karajari determination area, east of the Great Northern Highway
• Supporting infrastructure in the Karajari determination area, east of the Great Northern Highway.



Consultation and Consent Process: To assist the Karajari People understand the Gingerah Energy Project ILUA and as part of the KTALA's consultation and consent obligations, the KTALA is presenting community information sessions in Albany on 21 September, Perth on 26 September, Bidadjanga on 2 October and Broome on 3 October. There will also be online sessions on 24 and 27 September and for anyone who wasn't able to attend the community information sessions, the KTALA can provide copies of the summary material if requested.

Karajari People will be provided with limited travel and accommodation assistance to attend the meeting. For anyone who is unable to attend the meeting directly, please contact the KTALA office before Fri 4 October 2024 to register your intention to participate in the authorisation meeting online or by appointing a proxy. The KTALA will be seeking the approval of the Karajari People at the meeting to apply the proxy rule in Rule 4.12 of the KTALA Rulebook for the purposes of allowing Karajari People who cannot attend the meeting to appoint a proxy to participate in the decision making process (i.e. one proxy per person).

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
