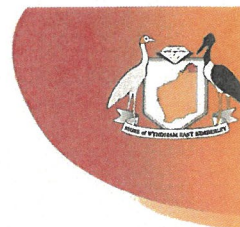

Firebreaks and Hazard Reduction Notice 2022

Notice to all owners and/or occupiers of land within the Shire of Halls Creek

PURSUANT to the powers contained in Section 33 of the Bush Fires Act 1954, all owners and/or occupiers of land within the Shire of Halls Creek are hereby required with effect from 15 April 2022 up to and including 31 December 2022, to have fire breaks and/or fire control measures installed and maintained in accordance with the following:

- Where the area of land is 2,000m² or less, all flammable material on the land shall be removed by close mowing, cultivation, grubbing, approved burning or approved spraying
- Where the area of land exceeds 2,001m² in area, a firebreak corridor at least 3.0 metres wide and 4.0 metres tall shall be cleared of all flammable material inside all external boundaries of the land and also surrounding all buildings situated on the land by cultivation, approved burning, or approved spraying.
- A building protection zone must be provided in all cases. The first 5 metres around buildings is to be cleared of all flammable material. Rectangular gardens may be located in this zone.
- Burning is prohibited from 1 May to 31 November 2022. A permit is required to burn, until 31 December 2022.

The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development invites submissions on the proposed declared pest rates for the financial year commencing on 1 July 2022 which are to be determined under section 130 of the Biosecurity and Agriculture Management Act 2007.

The Honorable Alannah MacTiernan Minister for Agriculture and Food proposes that the rates listed below be determined on land in certain prescribed Local Government Districts of Western Australia. Rates collected are matched by the State dollar for dollar. The combined funds are made available to Recognised Biosecurity Groups who provide support for landholders to fulfil their obligations to manage widespread and established declared pests on their land.

An opportunity to provide comment on the proposed rates is open from Saturday 2 April until midnight Sunday 1 May 2022. Submissions can be sent:

The proposed rates are:

- 5.884 cents in the dollar on the unimproved value of land held under pastoral leasehold in the local government districts of Carnarvon, Exmouth, Greater Geraldton, Murchison, Upper Gascoyne, Northampton and Shark Bay.
- 6.140 cents in the dollar on the unimproved value of land held under pastoral leasehold in the local government districts of Coolgardie, Dundas, Kalbarri-Boulder, Laverton, Leonora, Menzies, Nganyatsjatsku, Sandstone, Wiluna and Yalgam.
- 0.516 cents in the dollar on the unimproved value of the land held under pastoral leasehold in the local government districts of Broome, Derby-West Kimberley, Wyndham-East Kimberley and Halls Creek.
- 6.104 cents in the dollar on the unimproved value of the land held under pastoral leasehold in the local government districts of Cue, Meekatharra, Mount Magnet, Mount Marshall, Penpen and Yalgoo.
- 2.182 cents in the dollar on the unimproved value of land held under pastoral leasehold in the local government districts of Ashburton, East Pilbara, Karratha and Port Hedland.
- 0.04154 cents in the dollar on the unimproved value of freehold land in the local government districts of Dalwallinu, Koorde, Morawa and Penrith, that is no less than 100 hectares in area with a minimum rates payable amount of \$80.

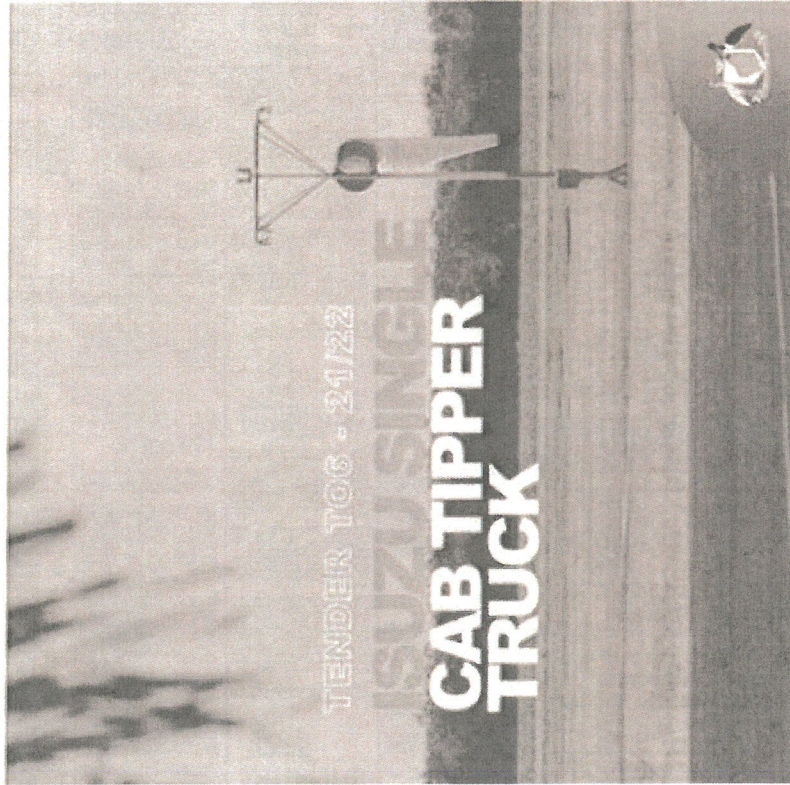
