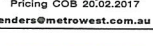

- iii. Grants approval to enter into a one year contract extension for T08-16/17 Provision of Traffic Management Services for a Period of One Year with Highways Traffic (Kimberley) Pty Ltd of 142 South Terrace, Fremantle WA 6160 in accordance with the tender documentation and the submitted schedule of rates. The one year contract extension is dependent on a satisfactory performance during the original one year contract term.
