- 1 - New tree planting, upgraded pedestrian paths and lighting with formalised on street parking connecting to the school/library

2 - Revitalised White Gum Park with cultural trail, gathering spaces, lighting and public art

3 - Landmark playspace with culturally interpretive play structures

4 - Formalised angle parking within road reserve and retained access to existing properties

5 - Community focussed development incorporating a cafe and public toilet

6 - Re-shaped parking layout with White Gum Street removed

7 - Lookout gathering space with views to the hills

8 - Konkerberry Drive re-modelled with continuous pedestrian paths, parallel parking, landscaped median, bioswales, extensive tree planting, street furniture and lighting upgrade

9 - Improved pedestrian paths, tree planting, powerlines underground, street furniture and formalised parallel parking

10 - New skatepark design to current standards, located as part of a dedicated Youth Hub precinct

11 - Dedicated RV parking hub
- 12 - Current Visitor Centre transformed into community Youth Hub (Public toilet, cafe, hub space)

13 - 'Eclipse Park' - revitalised open space

14 - Dedicated RV parking at Erythrina Street

15 - Generous pedestrian pathway next to Coolibah Drive shops with tree planting, shelters, seating, interpretive paving, atmospheric lighting and parking re-located

16 - Kununurra Town Square - incorporating landmark shade structure above cultural gathering space, retained and new trees, public art, small nature play, native planting, shaded seating and tables, atmospheric lighting and misters. Laneways activated with murals, catenary lighting and new paving. Service access retained through the laneways from Papuana St. to Banksia St. Over the medium to long term buildings can be potentially renovated to provide active edges with retail and food+beverage offerings with a potential arcade cut through to Coolibah Drive. New public toilet block.

17 - Lawn retained below existing mature shade trees

18 - Car park

19 - Coles and perimeter outlets. Potential for redevelopment in the medium to long term
- 20 - Telstra compound - upgraded with new fencing, landscaping, tower lighting and mural

21 - Cultural Trail with planted arbor, public art, seating and multiple rows of shade trees

22 - Cultural gathering space under mature trees

23 - Messmate Way upgrade with Cultural Trail

24 - New tree planting, upgraded pedestrian paths and lighting with formalised on street parking connecting to the hospital, Picture Gardens and Shire administration

25 - Development lot

26 - Messmate Way to be upgraded with wider planted median, pedestrian refuges, waiting lane to access the Thirsty Camel, footpath and lighting upgrades, tree planting and banner poles

27 - Cultural Trail to include both 3.5m shared paths and Country gravel path, boulders and bush planting, gathering spaces, lighting upgrades, public art, atmospheric 'Gobo' lighting

28 - Nature play

29 - Seasonal, 'wet season,' ephemeral water creek and boulders feature

30 - New RV parking hub
- 31 - Seasonal, 'wet season,' ephemeral water creek and boulders feature

32 - Safer Victoria Highway pedestrian crossings

33 - Landscaped pathway connecting to tourist accommodation

34 - Existing retail and cafe block

35 - RV parking with new footpath

36 - Existing service yard, potential to close access from Konkerberry Drive

37 - Service yards

38 - Formalised parking within road reserve

39 - Large scale navigational public art opportunity

40 - Relocated war memorial and flags

41 - Raised pedestrian wombat crossings to Banksia St, Papuana St, Cotton Tree Avenue, Ebony St and Tristania Street

42 - Kununurra Country Club

43 - Post office

44 - Recreation Centre
