It is respectfully requested that the Council consider installing concrete pedestrian refuge islands at the intersections of Erythina Street, Leichhardt Street and Ironwood Drive with Weaber Plain Road.

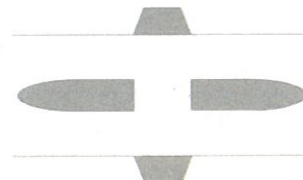

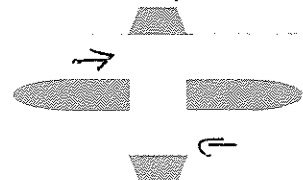

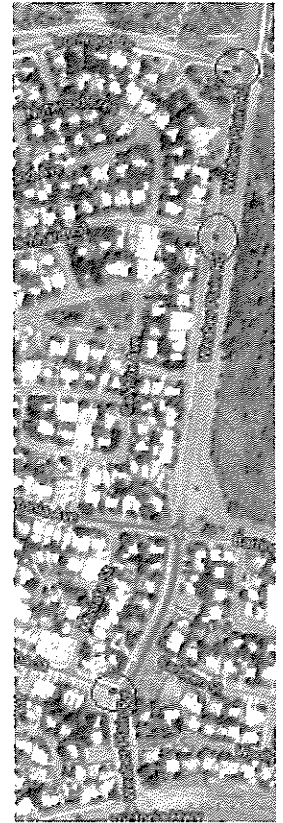
