

# Kununurra BMX Track Project

## Introduction

Kimberley Actions Sports Incorporated (KASI) has secured a site to build a BMX track in Kununurra.

Kununurra has a skate park within the CBD and KASI has established a Mountain Bike trail at Lake Argyle. However, there is currently no BMX track, jumps park, skills track or pump track in Kununurra.

## The Site

The site is located at the Racecourse/Rodeo Grounds “Sports Hub”.

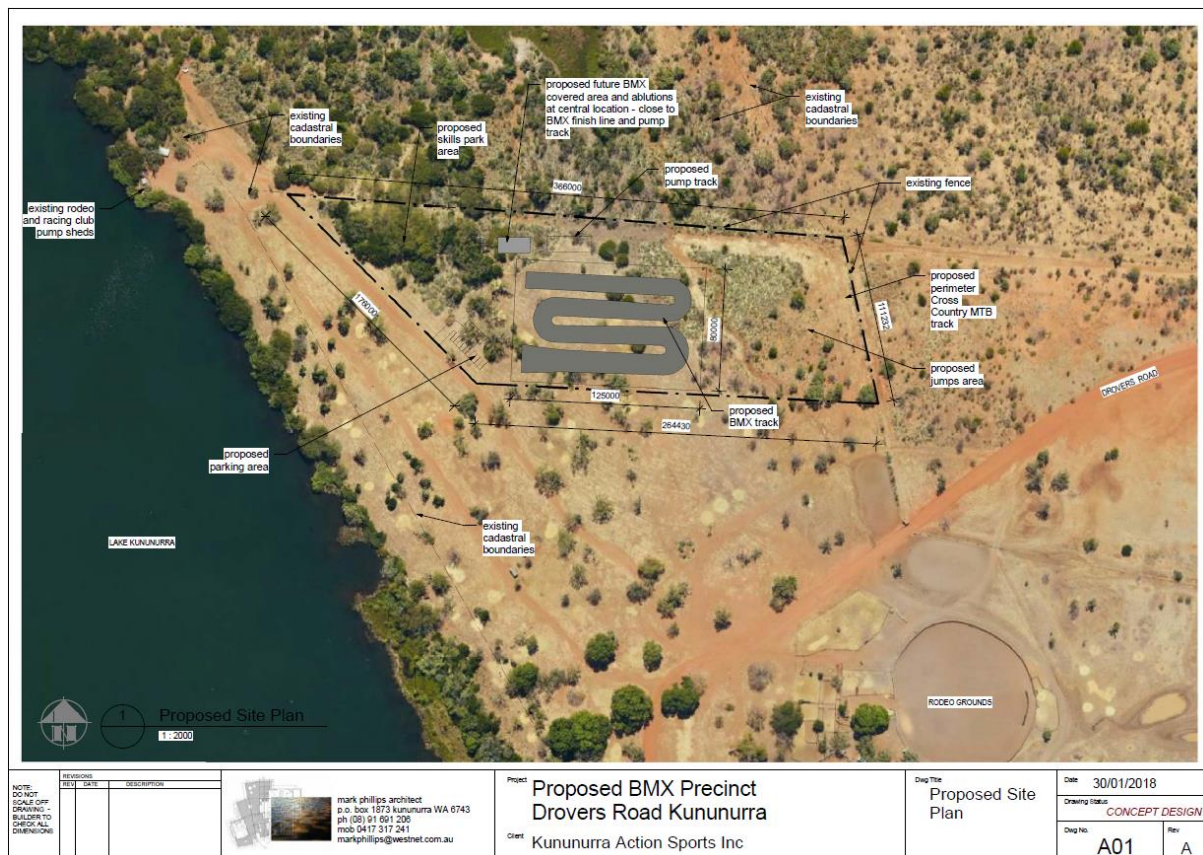


The site has a mix of sand and heavier soil types. During periods of high Wet Season rainfall (December to April) the site will become inaccessible to vehicles. Any patches of “black soil” become impassable.

There is a very gentle slope across the site from South to North. Drainage in this direction is consistent.

## Site Plan

A proposed site plan has been developed, with the BMX track forming the centre piece of the precinct.



## The BMX Track

Over the past five years, we have designed and build the foundations (earth works) for the BMX track. UCI BMX guidelines were used to ensure that the track is compatible with national standards.

The foundations provide a solid base to build on, as the berms and start ramp have settled over several wet/dry seasons.

The earth track has allowed us to confirm our 'proof of concept'.

The goal is to build a 'national level' BMX track.









## Request for Quote

KASI is seeking an itemised quote to:

- Finalise the track design and features,
- Design/confirm adequate track drainage,
- Surface, lay, compact and roll a minimum of 100mm of high quality 'laterite gravel' over the track surface and all aspects of the track features.
- Cover the surrounding area with a minimum of 10mm 'crusher dust' and compact.

The quote does not need to include access, surrounds, parking, fencing or any supporting infrastructure.

## Project Time Frames

The club is seeking to submit a detailed funding application by the end of August 2024 to the: Department of Sport and Recreation Facility Fund.

To meet the above deadline, we are seeking a detailed quote by 1<sup>st</sup> August 2024.

Funds from the above grant will become available early 2025, but any construction activity would occur in the Dry Season (June/July/August 2025).

### Information to assist with quote

It is anticipated that materials and machinery will be sourced locally.

Kununurra has a large Kennards Hire outlet, with significant earth moving equipment for hire. We also have several quarries and earth moving contractors and water carters. The largest earth moving contractors in Kununurra are JSW and Guerinoni and son.
