Alma Metals Australia Pty Ltd ("Alma") is a junior exploration company listed on ASX. Alma holds exploration licences in QLD, south-west Western Australia and Wyndham East Kimberley. Alma has paid Wyndham East Kimberley rates on 2 granted exploration licences (E80-5636 and E80-5637) in the past two years.

Invoiced shire rates for 2024/25 increased by more than double from 2023/24 which we believe to be incorrect and we note the following

- 1. Despite repeated attempts, we have been unable to contact Balanggarra Aboriginal Corporation to seek permission to access our licence. As such, after 2 years holding these licences, Alma staff have been unable to access the licence area for exploration purposes.
- 2. Alma is charged for waste management of \$200/ tenement / year. Alma does not use any waste services.
- 3. Other shires we engage with in QLD and Western Australia charge a "Minimum rate" on exploration licences

We respectfully request that consideration is given to reverse previously paid shire rates and re-charged at the minimum rates for 2022-23, 2023-24 and 2024-25 as per the attached calculation.
