ELECTION COMMITMENTS:

- **Weaber Plain Road/Mulligans Lagoon Road**
- **St Peters Way**

As you would be aware, the McGowan Government made a commitment during the recent State Election to provide funding to a number of projects on local government roads.

I am pleased to confirm the State Government's funding commitment to the following project(s) in the Shire of Wyndham East Kimberley:

- Weaber Plain Road/Mulligans Lagoon Road: Improve intersection visibility, widen intersection, install signs and delineation: with the State contribution capped at \$255K
- St Peters Way: Modify and formalise parking for cars and busses at Primary School, improve drainage, upgrade pedestrian facilities, install signs and pavement markings: with the State contribution capped at \$265K

The State Government funding for each project is provided as a grant, capped at the value shown above (GST exclusive). It is expected that any savings will be returned to the State at the completion of each project.

It is expected that the Shire of Wyndham East Kimberley will be responsible for the design and delivery of these projects.

The installation of temporary signs for information is not required. However, should you choose to install any such temporary signage these must bear the State Government logo and acknowledge that the State Government is funding the project. Written approval to the design of any signs must be obtained from Main Roads.

Approved funding for projects will be recouped by the Council from Main Roads in accordance in line with usual State Road Funds to Local Government Procedures, as follows:

- 40 per cent of Project Commitment - Advance when advised that the project has been approved.
- 40 per cent of Project Commitment - Incurred expenditure once the project has exceeded 40 per cent of the approved funding.
- 20 per cent of Project Commitment - Upon certification of satisfactory project completion of work.

Please liaise with Stacey Mulligan to confirm the proposed program for the works and that date upon which the first payment will be requested from Main Roads.
